



Safety Guide: B42

*Refer to SDS for safety and handling of B42
(50% potassium acetate solution, by weight)*

1. Exposure Prevention and Safety Measures

Personal protective equipment (PPE):

- Wear appropriate PPE (Refer to SDS): Eye protection, Nonporous boots, long sleeve shirt and pants.

Table 1. Exposure routes/precautionary measures: Avoid contact with eyes, skin, mouth

Exposure Routes	Safety Measures
Eyes	: Wash eyes thoroughly with clean water, if irritation persists seek medical attention
Dermal	: Wash exposed area with clean water, if irritation persists seek medical attention
Oral	: Do not induce vomiting, wash mouth with clean water, seek medical attention.

2. Application Safety Measures

Safe Application: Before application ensure personnel are outside of the spray zone.

Slip hazard: B42 may cause slipping hazards especially when applied/reapplied to surfaces with Ice, Snow, Sleet, hail.
